### How to Access Results Online

Go to SydPath website, <http://www.syddpath.com.au>

Select [Electronic Results](#) from the SydPath Menu to display the [Online Results Links for Registered Users](#)

Click on either the [Access for Medical Practitioners](#) or [Hospitals and Reference Laboratories](#) link as required.



You will be directed to the "SydPath Results Viewer – Tissue Pathology & Cancer Genetics Result Inquiry" screen where you will login with your Username and Password to display the Web Applications main page.

Login with the credentials provided by SydPath.

Pass-phrase must be a minimum of 8 characters with at least one number and/or a special character.

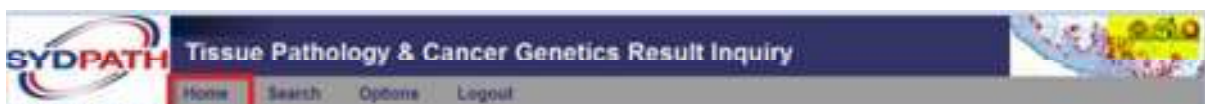

## HOME Tab



The "Home" screen displayed after logging in shows a Quick list of all resulted cases in the last 10 days, listed in alphabetical order.

Names in the "QuickList" will be in bold until the record has been viewed. Bold could mean an amended or supplementary report has been released.

## Search Tab



Search physician(s) displays the all the physician(s) codes associated to the user.

Patients can also be located using the "Search" option to filter results by Patient Name, DOB or Received dates.

Wild card searches on patient names are accepted eg. Surname Smith could be entered in as Smi

If your search has found multiple records for a single patient and you would like to view all, press "shift" key and the selected report will open, to view the next episode press "shift" on the second record. The two reports will both appear on your screen viewable side by side.

*NOTE: The MRN field is not the St Vincent's Hospital MRN*

## Viewing Results

To view results double click on a Patient and the test results will be displayed on screen in a new tab.

Once you have viewed the report press "F5" and the bold in the QuickList will be removed

**Images-** If patient reports have images, these will appear. To open into large format "Right click" and "Open Link"

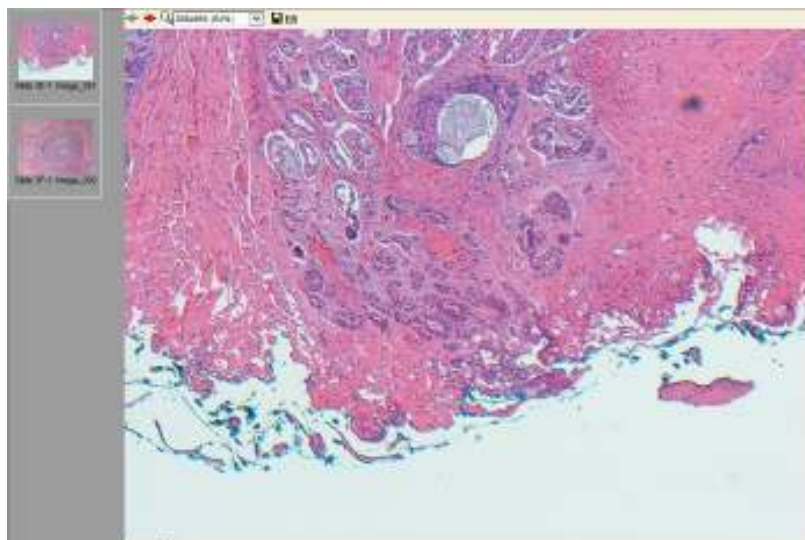
