



## SKIN CANCER CLINICAL & PATHOLOGY AUDIT

Our Skin Cancer Clinical & Pathology Audit provides general practitioners with relevant information to conduct a review of their clinical practice. Referring general practitioners will receive relevant information to assist with diagnostic & histological accuracy, collection methodology and surgical margin clearance.

The aim of this activity is to equip general practitioners with information in relation to skin lesions to ensure best patient outcomes. Our Anatomical Pathologists are available at any time to discuss the audit.

### RACGP QI & CPD PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

This Category 1 activity has been approved by the RACGP QI&CPD Program. Total Points: 40 Category One Points

- 40 points are awarded on completion of two consecutive reporting intervals with a minimum of 5 excision samples per interval.
- Doctors are required to complete and submit the Evaluation Form For General Practitioners on receipt of each six monthly audit report.

### REQUEST FORM AND DATA COLLECTION

The specialised Skin Audit Request Form contains standard questions regarding your patient's skin lesion. We collate this data to create your report. It is imperative that this information is supplied for reporting.

### YOUR CLINICAL AUDIT REPORT

Audit reports will be issued every six months with individual and peer comparison results. The reports will include:

- Number of patients
- Margin adequacy (where applicable)
- Breakdown of surgical management procedures
- Diagnostic concordance graph comparing clinical diagnosis with the pathology findings.
