

COVID-19 TESTING SERVICE

Who can be tested for COVID – 19?

Anyone with respiratory symptoms or unexplained fever

AND in particular

- Healthcare workers, aged care or residential care workers and anyone working in schools, detention facilities and other closed settings
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- People who have had close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case or have returned from overseas in the last 14 days.
- Anyone who lives or works in an area which has been identified as having elevated risk of community transmission.

OR

Anyone who has been referred by their GP for COVID-19 testing

St Vincent's COVID -19 Clinic Locations

East Sydney Community and Arts Theatre *

34 - 40 Burton Street, Darlinghurst (corner of Burton Street & Palmer Street)

Hours: 9 am - 4 pm, 7 days per week

Bondi Beach Drive-through Clinic *

Queen Elizabeth Drive Bondi Beach (Entry on junction of Campbell Parade and Beach Road).

Hours: 9 am - 4 pm, 7 days per week

*Both clinics only test individuals aged 16 years and older. Families can attend the Prince of Wales/Sydney Children's Hospital Randwick for testing of children under 16 years of age.

Test Results - Will be available within 72 hours of attending the clinic. Patients with valid mobiles will be sent their COVID-19 result via SMS (text message). Public Health as a priority will continue to contact patients who test positive for COVID-19.

If you had your COVID-19 test sample taken in the community by your GP you will need to contact your doctor for your COVID-19 result.

Fees-Cost of collection + testing is covered by Medicare.
